## **Generac Foundation Awards American Logistics Aid Network Grant To Support Disaster Response**

Lakeland, FL. – The American Logistics Aid Network announced today that the Generac Foundation has awarded a \$10,000 grant to support ALAN’s Coordinating Logistics Solutions program.
